What Is the Scorecard?

The Conservation Voters New Mexico (CVNM) Scorecard tells you the conservation score for each legislator from the 2011 and 2012 sessions combined (the 50th Legislature) so you can know if your Representative and Senator are representing your conservation values. The score is a percentage that indicates the number of pro-conservation votes the legislator cast out of all the votes that were scored. Where Does it Come From?

Each year at the State Legislature, CVNM advocates on legislation that impacts our air, land, water, wildlife and communities. After thorough analysis of the measures, and in consultation with the broader environmental community, we convey the "pro-conservation position" of each bill to all the members of the legislature. After the legislative session, CVNM compiles the important votes into a scorecard that gives each legislator an annual score. CVNM also computes the lifetime scores of legislators.

What's the Upshot?

Legislators with scores of 100%

- 27% of Senators
- 13% of Representatives

Legislators with scores of 0%

- 15% of Senators
- 0% of Representatives

Legislators with scores of 50% or more

- 46% of Senators
- 54% of Representatives

Legislators with scores below 50%

- 54% of Senators
- 46% of Representatives



Call or write to your legislators to let them know how you feel about their scores. Say thank you if they are doing well and let them know of your disappointment if they are not. Remind them that you will be paying attention in the future and that conservation matters to you.

If you look at the mailing label on this scorecard and you are a current member of CVNM, you will see the district numbers of your legislators right below your own name and address. You can find contact information for the legislators at www.CVNM.org/scorecard.

You can also take your contact to the next level. Invite your legislators for coffee or lunch and get

to know them a bit, giving them the opportunity to know you as well. New Mexico legislators are refreshingly accessible and eager to meet constituents. Building an ongoing relationship can help you be heard when the pace picks up.
